

INFORMATION

FIRING POINTS are all covered.

AMMUNITION will **not** be on sale.

REFRESHMENTS. A selection of snacks along with tea, coffee and squash will be available for purchase in the clubroom.

SMOKING. Long Ashton Range & Clubroom are non-smoking areas.

SECURITY. The Association cannot accept responsibility for articles owned by competitors or others at the meeting that may be damaged, lost or stolen from the Range or its surroundings. Rifles and other equipment should be locked securely and out of sight in your vehicle when not competing.

CAR PARKING is available on site. Vehicles are parked at their owner's risk. Neither the SSBSA or Long Ashton & District Association can accept responsibility for loss, damage or theft of or from vehicles parked at the Range or its surroundings.

DATA PROTECTION. The SSBSA will store the information provided on the entry form on a secure computer for the purposes of the administration of the competition, distribution of results & notification of future events. Forms will be retained for a period of up to six years after the competition. Results will be retained indefinitely for the purposes of future reference & maintaining historical records, and as such may be distributed to interested parties.

It is a condition of entry that competitors agree to their surname & initials, club & scores appearing in the results of the meeting, however these results may be published, including on the SSBSA website. The SSBSA will not use competitor's data for commercial or other purposes nor give permission for such use to a third party with the exception of Police forces and the Home Office upon formal request.

RESULTS. All results will be published on the SSBSA website and will be emailed to competitors supplying an email address on their entry form.

DIRECTIONS. The Long Ashton & District Rifle Range is located at Flax Bourton, North Somerset. Situated on the B3130, it is a quarter of a mile north of the A370 Junction. Bear left at the first double roundabout and immediately right before the second roundabout, then up the lane ahead of you through the set of green gates. COURSE

Double Dewar Match - 40 shots at 50m and 40 shots at 100yds.

CLASSES

The meeting will be shot in 4 classes according to declared averages:-

Class X	97.5 and over	Class A	96.0 to 97.4
Class B	93.5 to 95.9	Class C	93.4 and below

If no average is given Class X will be allocated.

All previous Class Winners will be placed in the next higher class in the following year.

The committee reserves the right to re-classify competitors.

SQUADDING NUMBERS & TIMES

Squad 1	09:00 – 11:10 hrs	CROSS
Squad 2	11:40 – 13:50 hrs	SQUADDING IS
Squad 3	14:20 – 16.30 hrs	NOT PERMITTED

The match will be shot over 4 details each of 20 minutes for unlimited sighters & 20 shots to count. Each squad will shoot the two distances consecutively.

- A 10-minute period will be allowed between details for change of targets except that a 30-minute period will be allowed between the 2nd and 3rd details of each squad to allow competitors sufficient time to move between the 50m and 100yd ranges.
- A 30-minute period will be allowed between squads to allow competitors sufficient time to prepare for the shoot.

COMPETITIONS

Open Competition

1. Aggregate – in 4 Classes: - X, A, B & C
2. Ladies Championship
3. Veterans Championship (Aged 60 or over on 31st December next)
4. Juniors Championship (Aged under 21 on 31st December next)
5. Pairs Championship – in 2 Classes: - X/A and B/C

Closed Competition

6. Astor Cup - SSBSA Affiliated Club teams of 6

All competitions will be shot concurrently.

RULES

- **NSRA Rules and Regulations** will apply except for ties. These will be decided on count-back starting from the bottom diagram on the second 100-yard card. In the event that scores remain tied, the 50m cards will be taken into account working back from the bottom pair of diagrams on the second card. The Range Committee will settle any disputes and their decision will be final.
- **Averages** should be calculated from the best 5 of the last 6 officially scored cards. Competitors will be allocated to each class in accordance with averages submitted, except for previous years winners who will be allocated to a higher class. The Range Committee reserves the right to reclassify any competitor whose declared average appears to be incorrect.
- **Teams** must comprise 6 members of the same SSBSA affiliated club.
- **Recorded Scores.** It is the responsibility of the competitor to ensure that their scores are correctly recorded on the exhibited lists. A score may be challenged on a deposit of £5.00, which will be returned if the challenge is upheld. The Association will not enter into any correspondence regarding missing or disputed scores after the close of the meeting.
- **Disciplinary matters.** The procedure for dealing with any disciplinary matters is fully documented within the "SSBSA Rifle & Airgun Competition Rules & Format", a copy of which is available upon request.
- **Range Register.** All competitors must sign the Range Register and visitors must sign the competition Clubroom Register available on the day.
- **Squadding.** Every competitor whose entry is accepted and entry fee paid will be squadded at his or her chosen time. Should the chosen squad be filled, the competitor will be offered whatever squad is available.
- **Squadding details,** including squad time, competitor number & firing point, will be displayed in the clubhouse. Squads will commence promptly at the times stated. Competitors must allow sufficient preparation time so as to be ready to shoot at those times.
- **Targets and backing cards** will be available on the firing point prior to your squadded time. Competitor number, firing point number, and detail number will be found on all targets and backers - is the competitor's responsibility to check that this information is correct. Queries must be resolved with the range officer before shooting commences.
- **Bulldog clips** are required - sufficient to attach the target card and backer.
- **Shot targets and backers** are to be handed to the Range Officer at the end of each detail.
- **Breech flags** must be inserted when rifles are not in use but uncovered and with the bolt or action in place.
- **Removal of equipment.** Competitors should remove their equipment from the firing point at the end of their last detail before collecting their targets.
- **No show.** In the event of a competitor being unable to attend, any entry fees paid, less 20%, will be refunded if the meeting organiser is informed at least 2 days before the meeting.
