Somerset Open Shoot – April 2025

Format

- 60 shots to count at 50m **OR** 40 shots to count at 20/25yds.
- 50m prone or bench rest must be on outdoor ranges.
- 20 or 25yds (or metres) prone or bench rest, on either indoor or outdoor ranges.
- The cards may be shot in either one or two sessions.
- **All cards must be shot within the month of April.**

The competitions are self-scoring (see rule 6). Scores must be submitted by email to the competition organiser by 12:00 noon on Friday 9th May.

Competitions

- Aggregate – In classes allocated according to submitted averages and numbers entering.
- Ladies Championship in each discipline.
- Veterans Championship in each discipline (Aged 60 or over on 1st April 2025)
- Junior Championship in each discipline (Aged under 21 on 30th April 2025)

Stickers

Stickers will be issued during the last week of March in order that the competition can commence on the 1st April.

Late entries

Late entries will be accepted up to the 7th April but all cards must be shot by the 30th April.

Scores

Scores should be recorded on a spreadsheet that will be emailed to you at the start of the competition. The completed spreadsheet must be emailed back to the competition organiser by 7th May. Late returns may not be accepted.

Results

Results will be issued by email shortly after 7th May. Medals will be posted to winners as soon as possible. All results will be published on the SSBSA website.

DATA PROTECTION. The SSBSA will store the information provided on this entry form on a secure computer for the purposes of the administration of the competition, distribution of results and notification of future events. Forms will be retained for a period of up to six years after the competition. Results will be retained indefinitely for the purposes of future reference and maintaining historical records, and as such may be distributed to interested parties.

It is a condition of entry that competitors agree to their surname and initials, club & scores appearing in the results of the meeting, however these results may be published, including on the SSBSA website.

The SSBSA will not use competitor's data for commercial or other purposes nor give permission for such use to a third party with the exception of Police forces and the Home Office upon formal request.

Rules

- 1. NSRA Rules and Regulations** will apply except for ties that will be decided as set out in rule 7 below.
- 2. Ranges**
All shooting must be conducted on approved ranges. 50m ranges must be outdoors.
- 3. Rifles and Equipment**
Any type of .22 calibre rifle, single shot, bolt or martini action rifle may be used. Telescopic sights may only be used in the bench rest competitions. Rifles, sights, clothing etc must conform to NSRA rules.
- 4. Targets**
Only NSRA targets bearing the “- 18” suffix to their reference number are acceptable.
- 5. Stickers**
The issued stickers must be applied to complete sets of target cards before shooting commences.
- 6. Scoring**
Scoring shall generally be in accordance with section 5 of the NSRA scoring regulations.
Scorers must be NSRA qualified to either Class A, B or C. If a suitably qualified scorer is not available cards may be posted to the competition organiser for scoring.
Only NSRA approved plug gauges may be used or the NSRA overlay gauge where necessary on 50m targets.
- 7. Ties**
Bench rest - the total number of Xs will be taken into account followed by countback from the last card.
Prone – will be decided on count back from the last card.
If scores still remain tied cards will be called in for scrutiny by the competition organisers.
- 8. Averages**
Averages should be calculated from the best 5 of the last 6 officially scored cards. Competitors will be allocated to classes in accordance with their submitted averages and the numbers entering each competition. The Association reserves the right to reclassify any competitor whose declared average appears to be incorrect and, if numbers entering any particular competition are small, to allocate only one or two classes in that competition.
